

(BLXT) The Port Road Scenario Pack (Train Simulator 2013)

Introduction

In this pack are included 20 scenarios to play on the route "The Port Road" (Steam version). Only freeware rolling stock is also necessary.

Languages of the scenarios: english, german, french and italian.

01) Early morning train ()

Summary: The first train of day from Kirkcudbright to Dumfries.

Date: January 1, 1960

Duration: 45 minutes

02) Last train of the day ()

Summary: The last train of the day between Dumfries and Kirkcudbright.

Date: November 24, 1966

Duration: 55 minutes

03) Last train of the day (modern) ()

Summary: The last train of the day between Dumfries and Kirkcudbright.

Date: March 3, 2008

Duration: 110 minutes

04) Freight train to Dalbeattie and back ()

Summary: Drive your freight train from Kirkcudbright to Castle Douglas and bring another train from Dalbeattie to Kirkcudbright.

Date: August 14, 1965

Duration: 70 minutes

05) Petroleum Express ()

Summary: Once a week a freight train transfers tank cars from Maxwelltown to Kirkcudbright and then brings other tank cars to Dumfries.

Date: January 2, 1981

Duration: 95 minutes

06) Express to Carlisle ()

Summary: An express train from Kirkcudbright to Carlisle.

Date: June 24, 1950

Duration: 60 minutes

07) Extra service to Castle Douglas ()

Summary: A scottish railfan association organized a extra trip from Carlisle to Portpatrick with an IC 125 train. You are the driver between Dumfries and Castle Douglas.

Date: June 10, 1975

Duration: 30 minutes

08) Shunting movements ()

Summary: A few shunting operations in Castle Douglas.

Date: October 24, 1969

Duration: 40 minutes

09) The Fishermen Arrow ()

Summary: Drive the seasonal express from Carlisle to Kirkcudbright. This train brings many people to the 'Fish Party' organized in Kirkcudbright.

Date: October 12, 1956

Duration: 50 minutes

10) The Cod Express ()

Summary: The 'Cod Express' is the name of the freight train that brings fresh cod to Carlisle from the port of Kirkcudbright.

Date: March 23, 1962

Duration: 60 minutes

11) Help on tracks ()

Summary: A Class 47 is in distress not far from Castle Douglas. With another Class 47, go and help it to join its destination.

Date: April 6, 2008

Duration: 40 minutes

12) Oil for all ()

Summary: Pick up tankers at Maxwelltown facility and dispatch them in two stations.

Date: January 4, 2001

Duration: 110 minutes

13) Summer night ()

Summary: You are operating a freight train from Dumfries to Castle Douglas.

Date: July 23, 2007

Duration: 40 minutes

14) Need for coal ()

Summary: A train of coal must distribute some full hopper cars to Dumfries station and takes the empty ones away.

Date: May 2, 1954

Duration: 35 minutes

15) Nostalgic journey ()

Summary: A nostalgic train is running between Portpatrick and Dumfries, but the steam engine shows some pressure problems. You have to complete the journey to Dumfries.

Date: August 23, 2005

Duration: 40 minutes

16) Vans to Dumfries ()

Summary: A freight train between Kirkcudbright and Dumfries with other stops on its way.

Date: September 9, 1963

Duration: 60 minutes

17) On the way to Stranraer ()

Summary: The express train to Stranraer is ready to depart. You'll have to drive as far as Castle Douglas.

Date: September 2, 1972

Duration: 25 minutes

18) Freight to the port ()

Summary: Some goods in Dumfries have to be delivered to Portpatrick's port. Assemble your train and drive as far as Castle Douglas.

Date: July 30, 1961

Duration: 50 minutes

19) Duties in Kirkcudbright ()

Summary: Shunting operations in Kirkcudbright.

Date: June 13, 1968

Duration: 40 minutes

20) Cutting the train ()

Summary: Shunting movements to dispatch the cars of an express train from Carlisle.

Date: March 23, 1970

Duration: 30 minutes

Installation

These scenarios are packaged in the same ".rwp" file. Install it through Train Simulator 2013 package manager that you will find in your railworks folder (Utilities.exe).
